Serging:

Beginner Serger: This class is for those who know very little about their sergers. Paced so that you can learn to use your serger properly and with confidence, the instructor will teach you many time saving tips and tricks to enable you to get the most out of your serger. You will make three practical projects to show off your new skills as well making samples for a sample book. TBA

Serger Broomstick Skirt: Learn how to use the differential feed on your serger to stitch up a wonderful warm weather skirt. \$30 Thurs March 20; 12:30-3:30pm

Serger Sweatshirt/T-shirt: Learn some super, time saving techniques in this quick and easy class. Students will learn how to cut and serge a T-shirt or Sweatshirt completely on the serger. \$30 Thurs April 3; 12:30-3:30pm

Cover Hem Sergers: A class set aside for those who have machines that do the cover hem. Learn how to thread your machine, start and stop stitching and make a simple project to show off your work. \$30 Thurs April 10; 12:30-3:30pm

Quilting:

1-2-3 Quilting: This is a great beginner class to learn how to use rotary tools properly, sew an accurate seam, quilt and bind the quilt. Students will have a choice of 3 different quilts in 3 different sizes. \$120 Mon March 10, 17, 24, 31; 6:0-9:30pm

Quilter's Primer: Our "other" beginner quilting class. This class is a 6-block sampler where in addition to the skills learned in 1-2-3 Quilting, you will learn how to make triangles, measure and add sashing and borders. \$150 (book included) Sat March 29, April 5, 12, 19, 26; 2-5pm

Photo Transfer: Learn how easy it is to print directly on fabric. Margaret has experimented with many tools and techniques and has a great presentation to inspire you. A work day will be scheduled at a later date. \$25 April 1, 6:30-9pm

Design A Lone Star: Love the look of the 8 pointed Lone Star Quilts, but don't have a clue how or where to start? Learn how easy it is to plan and sew this stunning quilt. Students will begin by looking at samples, then move on to deciding and planning their own quilt before purchasing the fabric and sewing the quilt top. Special attention will be paid to proper cutting, accurate sewing and speedy techniques to make this class and project a joy to complete. Allison \$90 Mon Feb 25 & March 3 & 10; 1-4pm

Curved Piecing: Learn to make curved, three-dimensional quilt blocks without ever sewing a curved seam! This technique produces 3-dimensional blocks without bulk and is ideal for table runners, wall hangings and even full sized quilts! Carol R \$60 Wed, Feb. 27 & March 5; 1-4pm

9-Patch Jacket: Play with the simple 9-patch blocks and create a stunning jacket to highlight a favorite fabric. Each section (back, fronts, sleeves) is made of a different arrangement of 9-patch blocks. The blocks are then quilted with very thin batting. The quilts are cut and sewn into a great stunning jacket.

Free Motion Quilting-Beginner: This class will have you creating beautiful quilting stitches in no time. Use a practice quilt to learn and master some beautiful fill stitches for your next quilt. Students will also learn how to use templates and master marking the quilt.

Free Motion Quilting - Feathers: Learn how to stitch beautiful feathers with no marking on the quilt. Students will learn 3 methods of stitching feathers. Allison March 3; 6:30-9:30pm

Hand Dyed Fabrics: If you have never dyed fabrics before, these classes are a lot of fun. Learn about basic colour theory, start working on a colour wheel, learn how to get texture and the mechanics of dyeing fabric. (Fabric and dye kit included) Allison TBA

- Our introductory class gives students a "taste" for the basics....learn how to dye.
- Our Colour Wheel class will guide you as you create a 12 step colour wheel
